- FIC ABELOVE            GO AND COME BACK  
Alicia, a young tribeswoman living in an Amazonian village in the Andes, tells about the two American women anthropologists who arrive to study the way of life of her people
- FIC AIKEN                TEETH OF THE GALE  
At the request of the nun with whom he is in love, eighteen-year-old Felix embarks on a perilous rescue mission across the strife-ridden town countryside of Spain in the late 1820s
- FIC ALEXIE              RESERVATION BLUES  
The life of Spokane Indian Thomas Builds-the -Fire irrevocably changes when blues legend Robert Johnson appears on his reservation and passes the misfit storyteller his enchanted guitar
- FIC ALVAREZ            HOW THE GARCIA GIRLS LOST THEIR ACCENTS  
Fifteen tales vividly chronicle a Dominican family's exile in the Bronx, focusing on the four Garcia daughter's rebellion against their immigrant elders
- FIC ALVAREZ            IN THE TIME OF BUTTERFLIES  
During the last days of the Trujillo dictatorship in the Dominican Republic, three young women, members of a conservative, pious Catholic family, who had become committed to the revolutionary overthrow of the regime, were ambushed and assassinated as they drove back from visiting their jailed husbands
- FIC ASTURIAS           THE PRESIDENT  
Originally appearing as El Senor Presidente, it was the story of a ruthless dictator and his schemes to dispose of a political adversary in an unnamed Latin American country usually identified as Guatemala
- FIC AVI                  BEYOND THE WESTERN SEA, BK 1: THE ESCAPE FROM HOME  
Driven from their impoverished Irish village, 15-year-old Maura and her younger brother meet their landlord's runaway son in Liverpool while all three wait for a ship to America
- FIC AVI                  BEYOND THE WESTERN SEA, BKII: LORD KIRKLE'S MONEY  
The fates of Maura, her younger brother and the landlord's son continue to intertwine on board ship and in the New World
- FIC AZUELA             THE UNDERDOGS  
Considered by many to be the definitive novel of the Mexican Revolution, this is the story of a peace-loving Indian who is forced to side with the rebels to save his family
- FIC BASU                THE STARS CAN WAIT  
Fifteen-year-old Gracian Sófka breaks curfew to star-gaze. But it is 1940 and the Germans are occupying Poland...
- FIC BAT-AMI             TWO SUNS IN THE SKY  
In the fall of 1944, approximately one thousand refugees from liberated Italy were brought to a refugee shelter in Oswego, New York. Two story lines intertwine--that of fifteen-year-old Yugoslav refugee Adam and fifteen-year-old Oswego native Christine
- FIC BECKER             THE BLUE-EYED SHAN  
The book opens in late 1949 with Chiang Kai-shek's China in its death throes.  
Mysterious messages from a wartime friend, an aristocratic, cosmopolitan general called Yang, who is leading a small column of ragtag Nationalist soldiers a few days ahead of the Chinese Communists, catapult Greenwood back to Pawlu on a fateful treasure hunt
- FIC BENITEZ            A PLACE WHERE THE SEA REMEMBERS  
Tender and gripping novel set in the Mexican village of Santiago about family relationships, love, and the tragedy that overcomes the villagers
- FIC BINCHY              LIGHT A PENNY CANDLE  
From the time in 1940 when shy, ten-year-old Elizabeth White is evacuated from wartime London and plunged into a large and contentious family in the Irish village of Kilgarret, she and Aisling O'Connor are destined to be closest friends-no matter their wildly different backgrounds and upbringing. How their lives resonate together and apart is the story this remarkable novel tells

FIC BINCHY	<p>SCARLET FEATHER Scarlet Feather is the catering company started by Tom Feather ;and Cathy Scarlet. They're talented and have found the perfect premises and funding but encounter endless events that complicate their vision</p>
FIC BO	<p>SKULLCRACK Jonah, a troubled boy who escapes from his dreary life with an alcoholic father by surfing on the coast of Ireland, discovers that he has a twin sister with whom he has an unusual link.</p>
FIC BOSSE	<p>THE EXAMINATION Fifteen-year-old Hong and his older brother Chen face famine, flood, pirates, and jealous rivals on their journey through 15th century china</p>
FIC BUCK	<p>DRAGON SEED A novel of China in World War II</p>
FIC CALDWELL	<p>CAPTAINS AND THE KINGS This is a great novel about the amassing of a colossal fortune, the political power that comes with it, and the operation of a curse laid on an Irish-American dynasty and the ruthless, driving man who founded it</p>
FIC CALVERT	<p>THE HOUR OF THE WOLF Following his suicide attempt, a loner and a loser who has never lived up to his father's expectations is sent to Alaska, where he subsequently enters the annual thousand-mile-long Iditarod Trail Race from Anchorage to Nome in memory of his Athabascan Indian friend who dies</p>
FIC CARLSON	<p>THE BEGGAR KING OF CHINA A fictional account of the farmer's son whose leadership of rebel forces resulted in overthrowing the Chinese government and establishing him on the throne as the first ruler of the Ming dynasty</p>
FIC CARR	<p>EYE KILLERS Lurking in the caves of eastern New Mexico, Falke, a thousand-year-old vampire, chooses his next bride, Melissa Roanhorse, an Albuquerque teenager. To regain his granddaughter's life, Michael Roanhorse, an old Navajo sheepherder wise to the power of myth, must outwit the vampire and his loyal coven</p>
FIC CHENG	<p>MARIKA Although she has been raised Catholic, Marika learns how dangerous it is to be of Jewish heritage and living in Hungary during World War II</p>
FIC CHOI	<p>GATHERING OF PEARLS Sookan struggles to balance her new life as a college freshman in the United States with expectations from her family at home in Korea</p>
FIC CISNEROS	<p>CARAMELO A folk-saga of Mexican migrants told by a curious little girl who has the wisdom of an old grandma</p>
FIC CLAVELL	<p>SHOGUN Epic action, passion, adventure as warrior over-lords struggle for power in feudal Japan</p>
FIC COEL	<p>THE SHADOW DANCER Another mystery set on the Wind River Reservation starring Arapahoe attorney Vicky Holden and her friend Father John O'Malley</p>
FIC COEL	<p>THE SPIRIT WOMAN Arapahoe attorney Vicky Holden and her confidante, Father John O'Malley, find themselves drawn into a long-hidden mystery torn from the pages of history, which threatens to expose a secret of the past--and a killer in the present</p>
FIC COLDSMITH	<p>THE ELK-DOG HERITAGE Chief Heads-Off brought horses-the "elk-dogs"-to the People. FIC COSTAIN	<p>HIGH TOWERS</p> <p>An historical romance chronicling the adventures of the fabulous Le Moyne family of Montreal who became the heroes of French Canada and founded the storied city of New Orleans. Early 18th century</p>
FIC CROUTIER	<p>LEYLA:THE BLACK TULIP</p> <p>While trying to help her financially destitute family, twelve-year-old Leyla ends up on a slave ship bound for Istanbul, then in the beautiful Topkapi Palace, where she discovers that life in the sheltered world of the palace harem follows its own rigid rules and rhythms and offers her unexpected opportunities during Turkey's brief Tulip Period of the early 1700's</p>
FIC DAI	<p>BUTTERFLY LOVERS</p> <p>A beautiful girl disguises herself as a man and lives under one roof with a young male scholar for three years without revealing her true identity. They become "sworn brothers", soul mates and lovers. In a world in which marriage is determined by social status and arranged by parents, what is their inescapable Romeo-and-Juliet-type of fate</p>
FIC DANGAREMBGA	<p>NERVOUS CONDITIONS</p> <p>Set in colonial Rhodesia in the 1960s, this is an evocative story of a girl's coming of age and a compelling portrayal of the devastating human loss involved in the colonization of one culture by another</p>
FIC DE MAUPASSANT	<p>BEL-AMI</p> <p>Written when Maupassant was at the height of his powers, <u>Bel-Ami</u> explores the extremes of splendour and squalor, life and death. Georges Duroy, "Bel-Ami", is a provincial determined to succeed in the corrupt Paris of the Third Republic</p>
FIC DESAI HIDIER	<p>BORN CONFUSED</p> <p>Seventeen-year-old Dimple, whose family is from India, discovers that she is not Indian enough for the Indians and not American enough for the Americans, as she sees her hypnotically beautiful, manipulative best friend taking possession of both her heritage and the boy she likes</p>
FIC DORRIS	<p>A YELLOW RAFT IN BLUE WATER</p> <p>Lyrical saga of three generations of Indian women beset by hardship and torn by angry secrets</p>
FIC DORRIS	<p>CLOUD CHAMBER</p> <p>A masterful novel about the effects of time and memory on succeeding generations of a family fueled by fierce anger, repressed passions and determined will. Irish Americans</p>
FIC EMBRY	<p>SHADI</p> <p>A Navajo girl takes her responsibility as big sister very seriously, especially after her mother dies, leaving no one else to care for the baby</p>
FIC ERDRICH	<p>LOVE MEDICINE</p> <p>An unforgettable drama of anger, magic, and healing in the lives of two Native American families</p>
FIC ERDRICH	<p>THE ANTELOPE WIFE</p> <p>A powerful story capturing the sense of despair, destiny, and magic through three generations of a Native American family</p>
FIC FAULKNER	<p>INTRUDER IN THE DUST</p> <p>Modern classic novel about small-town Southern Justice in which Lucas Beauchamp, a Negro, is accused of killing a white man</p>
FIC FENADY	<p>CLAWS OF THE EAGLE</p> <p>In this vivid blend of fact and fiction, Fenady recreates the Apache wars of the 1880s and the surrender of Geronimo to the U.S. Army</p>
FIC FORD	<p>THE GOOD SOLDIER</p> <p>This book has been called everything from the consummate novelist's novel to one of the greatest English works of the century. It revolves around two couples before and during World War I</p>
FIC FORESTER	<p>HORNBLOWER SAGA</p> <p>The most famous naval adventures of all times. Horatio Hornblower. 1800's</p>

FIC FORMAN	<p>THE SURVIVOR An account of a Jewish family in Holland during World War II as one by one it dwindles away during the Nazi holocaust</p>
FIC FRY	<p>COME A LONG JOURNEY About two men of different races becoming friends as their canoe travels down the wild Yukon River along the deserted Klondike Gold Rush trail</p>
FIC GAAN	<p>LITTLE SISTER When Little Sister comes to visit her grandparents in Shanghai, she is the third generation of her Chinese-American family to be drawn into the eye of the political storm that is revolutionizing China</p>
FIC GEAR	<p>THE SUMONING GOD Book two in the Anasazi Mysteries series, this is the sequel to <i>The Visitant</i>. Archaeologist-authors Kathleen O'Neal Gear and W. Michael Gear introduce readers to murder, mayhem, and the myriad details of life in a 13th century Native American pueblo</p>
FIC GARCIA MARQUEZ	<p>LOVE IN THE TIME OF CHOLERA Florentino Ariza's unrequited love survived almost 52 years after Fermina Daza ran away with a doctor and Florentino builds a life of his own</p>
FIC GOLDEN	<p>MEMOIRS OF A GEISHA</p>
FIC GREELEY	<p>IRISH GOLD A thrilling tale of love and danger, set against the Irish troubles of the past and present from the New York Times bestselling master of suspense. Irish Gold revolves around a hidden fortune in gold and the real-life, still-unsolved, question of who killed Free Irish leader Michael Collins in 1922</p>
FIC HARRIS	<p>FIVE QUARTERS OF THE ORANGE Framboise Dartigan is the proprietor of a café in a rustic village in France. This crabby old lady recalls the days of her childhood which coincided with the German occupation</p>
FIC HARRISON	<p>BROTHER WIND Historical novel set in the Ice Age as two women fight for survival</p>
FIC HARRISON	<p>MOTHER EARTH, FATHER SKY Set against the prehistoric splendor of the last Ice Age, this is a novel of extraordinary historical detail about one woman's struggle for survival</p>
FIC HEARN	<p>ACROSS THE NIGHTINGALE FLOOR Book One of Tales of the Otori. Will an unlikely assassin cross the famous nightingale floor?</p>
FIC HENRY	<p>THE BEAR PAW HORSES When Crazy Horse was dying, he told the seventy-year-old Crowfoot to get their Oglala horse s from the white man who stole them. Thus starts an incredible journey to retrieve the 400 stolen horses and take them to Joseph and his Nez Perces</p>
FIC HILLERMAN	<p>COYOTE WAITS Jim Chee and Lt. Leaphorn investigate when a Navajo shaman is accused of murder</p>
FIC HILLERMAN	<p>THE DARK WIND Tribal policeman Jim Chee investigates a vandalized windmill, an unidentified corpse, stolen jewelry and a missing load of cocaine</p>
FIC HILLERMAN	<p>THE FALLEN MAN Two police officers try to connect a skeleton and a sniper only after the situation hits too close to home</p>
FIC HILLERMAN	<p>THE GHOSTWAY Jim Chee is a Navajo cop who knows what is and what isn't a clue when the FBI can't find out</p>

FIC HOBBS	<p><b>BEARSTONE</b>  In a coming-of-age adventure along Colorado's Continental Divide, a troubled Indian boy and an elderly rancher help each other realize their dreams in a dramatic story of friendship, grizzlies and gold</p>
FIC HOBBS	<p><b>GHOST CANOE</b>  Fourteen-year-old Nathan, fishing with the Makah in the Pacific Northwest finds himself holding a vital clue when a mysterious stranger comes to town looking for Spanish treasure</p>
FIC HOLMAN	<p><b>THE MURDERER</b>  A young Jewish boy encounters numerous problems growing up during the Depression in a Pennsylvania mining town</p>
FIC HOBLER	<p><b>THE GHOST IN THE TOKAIDO INN</b>  While attempting to solve the mystery of a stolen jewel, Seikei, a merchant's son who longs to be a samurai, joins a group of kabuki actors in eighteenth-century Japan</p>

FIC HURSTEN	<p><b>THEIR EYES WERE WATCHING GOD</b>  An American classic about a young black woman and her coming to an understanding about love and happiness</p>
FIC ISSACS	<p><b>TORN THREAD</b>  In an attempt to save his daughter's life, Eva's father sends her from Poland to a labor camp in Czechoslovakia, where she and her sister survive the war</p>
FIC JENKINS	<p><b>THE HONORABLE PRISON</b>  Because of the moral stand taken by her father, a newspaper editor who has persistently attacked the military dictator ruling their Latin American country, Marta and her family find themselves prisoners of the government</p>
FIC JONES	<p><b>REMEMBER SANTIAGO</b>  United States-History-war of 1898</p>
FIC JONES	<p><b>ROMAN</b>  In 1865, Roman heads out of Arkansas to Kansas. He experiences a journey through the building of the railroad, the settling of Kansas and the West and the conflict with the Plains Indians. He eventually does find the Cheyenne-those Indians with the beautiful name!</p>
FIC JONES	<p><b>SEASON OF YELLOW LEAF</b>  In the late 1830s, a ten-year-old white girl is captured on a raid along the Edwards Plateau. This is the story of that girl growing up in a strange place. She is called "Chosen" by the Comanches and eventually becomes one of them</p>
FIC KELLEY	<p><b>A DIFFERENT DRUMMER</b>  This remains one of the most trenchant and hard-hitting works of fiction to come out of the bitter struggle for African-American civil rights. The extraordinary story of Tucker Caliban, a quiet, determined descendant of a magnificent African chief brought to America in chains</p>
FIC KENEALLY	<p><b>SCHINDLER'S LIST</b>  A German businessman tries to save his Jewish employees from the Nazi Holocaust</p>
FIC KIM	<p><b>THE LONG SEASON OF RAIN</b>  Atmospheric novel set in South Korea in 1969 about an 11-year-old orphan boy who stirs up an array of emotions within a wealthy family</p>
FIC KINGSOLVER	<p><b>THE POISONWOOD BIBLE</b>  A story told by the wife and four daughters of Nathan Price, a fierce, evangelical Baptist who takes his family and mission to the Belgian Congo in 1959. A suspenseful epic of one family's tragic undoing and remarkable reconstruction over the course of three decades in postcolonial Africa</p>

FIC KINGSTON	<p>TRIPMASTER MONKEY  Wittman Ah Sing is a young Chinese-American hippie in San Francisco. Driven by his dream of writing and staging an epic production of interwoven Chinese novels and folktales, his life becomes an extraordinary journey through an era as fantastic as his ambition</p>
FIC KLASS	<p>BREAKAWAY RUN  Seventeen-year-old Tony, a soccer player whose parents are divorcing, goes to Atami, Japan, to spend four-and-a-half months with a Japanese family</p>
FIC KLASS	<p>DANGER ZONE  Basketball, racism, and international terrorism combine in this story of an international high school basketball player's confrontation of fear</p>
FIC LaDUKE	<p>LAST STANDING WOMAN  Stories of the Ojibive/Chippewa tribes woven into a novel</p>
FIC LARSEN	<p>THE WHITE  In 1758, Mary Jemison was taken from her home in Pennsylvania by a Shawnee raiding party. This is the story about her life as a Seneca Indian</p>
FIC LAUDER	<p>NOBLE LORD  Intrigue, terrorism and horse racing from the island of Antigua to Great Britain</p>
FIC LEFFLAND	<p>RUMORS OF PEACE  The place is Mendoza, thirty miles east of San Francisco. The time is World War II from the bombing of Pearl Harbor until the bombing of Hiroshima. Suse Hansen evolves from a tomboy to a young person whose moral growth has been as remarkable as her blossoming into womanhood</p>
FIC LEVI	<p>IF NOT NOW, WHEN?  Based on a true story, this chronicles the adventures of a courageous band of Jewish partisans as they make their way from Russia to Italy-their ultimate goal being Palestine. Waging a personal war of revenge against the Nazis, they blow up trains, rescue the last victims of concentration camps, etc.</p>
FIC LEVITIN	<p>ROOM IN THE HEART  A story of the Danish Jews' miraculous escape from the Nazis as seen primarily through the alternating narratives of two young people</p>
FIC LIPSYTE	<p>THE BRAVE  Having left the Indian Reservation for the streets of New York, seventeen-year-old boxer Sonny Bear tries to harness his inner rage by training with Alfred Brooks, who has left the sport to become a policeman</p>
FIC LIYSYTE	<p>WARRIOR ANGEL  Native American boxer of the Moscondaga Nation, Sonny Bear must fight to retain his heavyweight championship title</p>
FIC MALAMUD	<p>ASSISTANT  The protagonists struggle to exist in the non-Jewish world around them</p>
FIC MALAMUD	<p>THE FIXER  This is the story of Yakov Bok, accused of murder as part of an anti-Semitic movement, and how he becomes a hero</p>
FIC MARTEL	<p>LIFE OF PI  Story of an Indian boy who finds himself adrift in the ocean with a 450 lb. tiger.</p>
FIC MARTINEZ	<p>PARROT IN THE OVEN: MI VIDA  Vibrant story of a Chicano boy's priorities, his family's life as Mexican Americans, and his brother's struggle with alcoholism</p>
FIC MATAS	<p>IN MY ENEMY'S HOUSE  Marisa, a blond, blue-eyed Jewish girl in WWII Poland passes as a Polish peasant and gets a job working for a Nazi family. She experiences a predictable romance with a rebellious cousin and eventually obtains work in Germany</p>
FIC MOMADAY	<p>HOUSE MADE OF DAWN  A fictional story based on the author's Indian ancestors</p>
FIC MOREY	<p>DEATH WALK  Teenager Joel Rodgers is stranded in the Alaskan wilderness in this suspenseful adventure story.</p>
FIC MORI	<p>SHIZUKO'S DAUGHTER</p>

	A young Japanese girl struggles with the haunting memories of her mother, who committed suicide
FIC MORI	<p>ONE BIRD</p> <p>Mourning her parent's divorce and resenting having to stay with a cranky grandmother, fifteen-year-old Megumi takes a part-time job with a wise veterinarian and finds peace while helping to care for sick birds</p>
FIC MORRISON	<p>BELOVED</p> <p>In post-Civil War Ohio, the past continues to haunt the ex-slave Sethe and the surviving members of her family</p>
FIC NAMIOKA	<p>TIES THAT BIND, TIES THAT BREAK</p> <p>Ailin's life takes a different turn when she defies the traditions of upper-class Chinese society by refusing to have her feet bound</p>
FIC NAIDOO	<p>CHAIN OF FIRE</p> <p>When the villagers of Bophelong are forced to leave their houses and resettle in a barren "homeland", thirteen-year-old Naledi and her younger brother join in a school demonstration</p>
FIC NEWTH	<p>THE TRANSFORMATION</p> <p>For several years, the Inuits of Greenland have suffered from unusually hard winters that do not let up. Navarana, a young Inuit woman, has lost both her parents to these terrible times. She decides to become a hunter and a shaman to help her people. Then, she accidentally finds and saves Brendan, a young Irish monk</p>
FIC NICHOLS	<p>THE MILAGRO BEANFIELD WAR</p> <p>Joe Mondragon stopped his truck, pulled on his gumboots, marched into the field and illegally tapped into the main irrigation channel</p>
FIC O'BRIEN	<p>THE CONTRACT SURGEON</p> <p>Dr. McGillycuddy is a surgeon pulled West by the Army for the Great Sioux War of 1876. He learns that he knows the legendary Sioux Leader, Crazy Horse, from a previous non-war situation and becomes his friend</p>
FIC O'DELL	<p>THE BLACK PEARL</p> <p>In claiming as his own the magnificent black pearl he finds, a sixteen-year-old youth enrages the sea devil whom legend says is its owner</p>
FIC O'DELL	<p>STREAMS TO THE RIVER, RIVER TO THE SEA</p> <p>A fictionalized version of the life of Sacagawea, the Shoshone guide for the Lewis and Clark expedition</p>
FIC ONDAATJE	<p>ANIL'S GHOST</p> <p>Anil Tissera returns to her homeland of Sri Lanka as a forensic anthropologist sent by an international human rights group to discover the source of the organized campaigns of murder engulfing the island</p>
FIC OSA	<p>CUBA 15</p> <p>Violet Paz, a Chicago high school student, reluctantly prepares for her upcoming "quince," a Spanish nickname for the celebration of a Hispanic girl's fifteenth birthday</p>
FIC PECK	<p>FAWN</p> <p>At the time of the Battle of Ticonderoga in 1758, an Indian boy, the son of a Jesuit priest, observes the savagery of the French, English, and Indians, and tries to save his father from what could be a terrible fate</p>
FIC PHIPSON	<p>HIT AND RUN</p> <p>Sixteen-year-old Roland's hit-and-run accident in a borrowed car sends him fleeing into the wild Australian countryside, where he struggles for both survival and self-respect</p>
FIC POTOK	<p>THE BOOK OF LIGHTS</p> <p>Gershon Loran, a quiet rabbinical student, is troubled by the dark reality around him. He sees hope in the study of Kabbalah, the Jewish book of mysticism and visions, truth and light</p>
FIC POTOK	<p>THE PROMISE</p> <p>Danny and Reuven help the teen-age son of a Jewish professor face his psychological and emotional problems</p>
